Anything published in St. Louis Reflections will not be included in this anthology.

Submission Guidelines **Please read carefully**

You must be a member of SLWG to be considered for this anthology. All submissions must be unpublished, original works about St. Louis, Missouri. You may submit up to three pieces in any of the approved formats. Short Story and Essay submissions must be titled, typed in 12 point, Times New Roman black font, double spaced with indented paragraphs, and page numbers.

There is **no submission fee**

Limit of **3 (three)** submissions per member

All submissions must adhere to the theme of the anthology – St. Louis Anniversary

Poems: 40 Lines per poem maximum, not including title. Any poetry format is acceptable

Short Stories & Essays: 2500 word limit per piece, not including title

Deadline: January 1, 2014.

Submission: Paste each entry into the body of an email along with the biographical data requested above or attach them to the email in a single .doc or .docx file. All submissions must be submitted electronically, this will primarily be an e-published anthology. Please email entries to: **submissions@stlwritersguild.net**

Selection: All submissions will be reviewed by the SLWG board of directors. Contributors will be chosen by a vote of the board.

Announcement of Accepted Submissions: Please note – SLWG will not notify all contributors concerning the outcome. Authors accepted for publication will be notified by the board of directors or the editor. Accepted contributors will receive a free copy of the anthology but will not be paid for their submission(s).

Publication Rights: All accepted contributors release first one-time rights to SLWG to publish their work(s) in this anthology. Excerpts may also be used in the advertising of the anthology. The editor reserves the right to edit all submissions. All copyrights belong to their authors and St. Louis Writers Guild. All Rights Reserved.
